HUSTON

HUSTON

FELD

HUSTON

I know.

FELD

They are scary! I really do think there is a monster under my bed.

HUSTON

I--

FELD

I know you check every night but I think it might just be a sneaky monster who is good at hiding.

HUSTON

I don't think so.

FELD

I don't think it'll hurt me though. I think it's the kind of monster that just likes being scary but doesn't really do anything. It's not the eating type of monster.

HUSTON

You're just talking about that old film now.

FELD

Huh?

HUSTON

The one about the monsters.

FELD

Huston, we can't watch films. Haven't been able to for like 1000 whole years.

HUSTON

It's not 1000--

FELD

We're learning about that in school. About old ways people used to entertain themselves and have fun. They had a lot of ways to have fun. And so much information everywhere. Did you know that? Did you know they had things that just brought up games and information and--

HUSTON

Yes.

FELD

It's so cool! My teacher says they might still have some of them on the East Coast and they definitely have some in Europe but definitely not any on the West Coast. She says the West Coast is basically just a wasteland. Just empty houses and people living in old tents and stuff.

HUSTON

Well--

FELD

I don't know about that though. I would still probably go there if I had the chance.

HUSTON

To the West Coast over the East Coast?

FELD

Yeah! It seems like there are so many things to discover.

HUSTON

Like what?

FELD

Like...I dunno. Almost home, I need to tell Bridgett about Bunt! Race you!
