IN A LANDMARK DEAL brokered, large part, by the Jiang family, Hong Kong will no longer be a part of China.

After a marathon negotiation session lasting six weeks, the Chinese delegations made stunning concessions to those of Hong Kong. While the details of the deal are not known in full, The New Guardian has uncovered that the terms of the separation of powers includes the exclusive donation of over 700,000 soldiers to the newly named International Republic of Hong Kong.

The agreement comes after decades of turmoil and protests. Thousands have been killed in the pursuit of Hong Kong becoming a free and democratically run nation and the Chinese government has been fighting protests for the last six years.

This independence will be the second in Hong Kong's history, following the successful protests in the early 21st Century that led to seventy-five years of sovereignty before the Hong Kong government ran short of funds and requested to be reintegrated into China. It is widely accepted that shadow business dealings from China were the cause of this economic collapse.

Both governments are refusing to comment on the record but, in a strange turn of events, An Jiang, patriarch of the Jiang family released a sweeping comment. We have copied the statement in full at the end of this article.

The Jiang family is known as royalty bordering on divine in both China and Hong Kong. Though no one quite knows how they rose to prominence, their inclusion in all major deals on the continent of Asia and beyond is a well-known fact. An Jiang is known as the third richest person on earth and his wife, Qiuyue is seventh. It is purported that the full amount of their wealth is much more than reported.

Quote from An Jiang:

"This is an historic day for the citizens of our fair island and the new International Republic of Hong Kong. For too long, Hong Kong and China have forced themselves to be a singular culture only to the detriment of the citizens of Hong Kong. With this new agreement, China has recognized the sovereignty of this great island and everyone who has fought for this great cause. Myself and the Jiang family are proud to have had a small part in the negotiations and we look forward to mutual prosperity for everyone moving forward."
